


Daily New Positives 7-Day Moving Average




30 children under age 15 have died from Covid-19.

Estimated Share of Inpatient Beds Occupied by Confirmed or Suspected COVID-19 Patients





March 17, 2020 - July 15, 2020





Weekly Number of Positive COVID-19 Tests by Age Group for **Commercial and Public Testing**




