


U.S. COVID-19 Vaccine Doses Administered by Vaccine Type



December 21, 2020 - February 24, 2021, 7-Day Moving Average





As of February 24, 2021, 6,724,310 vaccinations in Long-Term Care facilities have been administered to residents and staff. So far, 2,194,224 residents and staff have

received two doses. Less than 1% of the U.S. population live in Long-Term Care facilities, but residents in those facilities have accounted for 35% of all COVID-19 deaths.



As of February 24, 2021


