

Daily Reported New Positive COVID-19 Tests vs. Daily Reported Deaths with COVID-19 in the U.S.




U.S. COVID-19 Vaccine Doses Administered by Vaccine Type As of March 31, 2021






American Airlines expects to reactivate most of its aircrafts in the second quarter after seeing a major increase in bookings that has brought business back to near pre-pandemic levels. Bookings are at 'approximately 90%' of 2019 levels and planes are filling up, the airline said.³

A new CDC study of health workers found that one dose of Pfizer or Moderna vaccines was 80% effective in preventing COVID-19, but two doses are better than one, the CDC said, adding that the vaccines' effectiveness jumped to 90% two weeks after the second dose.¹

Total Deaths and COVID-19 Deaths in the U.S. by Age Group



Percentage of Schools Conducting Fully In-Person Learning



A recent study by John P.A. loannidis of Stanford University showed that available evidence suggests an **average global infection fatality rate of** ~0.15% and ~1.5-2.0 billion infections by February 2021 with substantial differences in infection fatality rates and in infection spread across continents, countries and locations.²
